Our mission is to prevent fatality and injury by educating the public on seat belt safety through school programs, community outreach, and awareness campaigns.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Seat belt safety school programs consist of a safety presentation, a seat belt check, and seat belt safety road signs. We also utilize school athletic events and extra-curricular events to launch seat belt safety awareness with the presence of the Kailee Crash Car or TXDOT's Rollover Convincer, distribution of safety merchandise, and videos.




